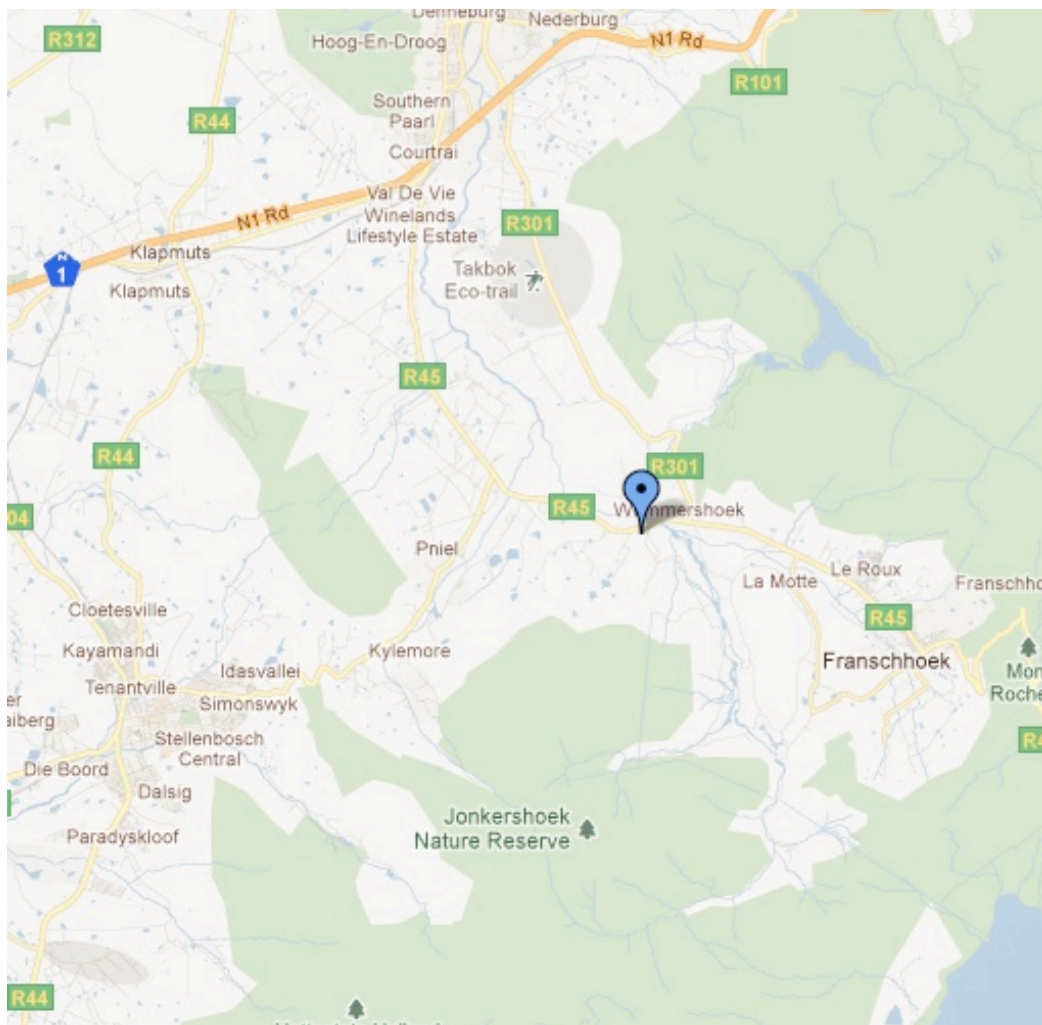

General

Plastrons must be worn. No tracksuit pants may be worn; breeches and long socks only.

Weapons checks will be held before the event and again before the semi-finals and finals. Weapons, body wires, masks and electric jackets must be presented at the weapon's check table.

Any fencer on the piste must have access to 2 working weapons.

The wearing of electrical bib masks and mask clips for the direct elimination rounds of foil events will be compulsory.

FIE referees may not refuse to referee if called upon to do so.



No competition will be delayed for missing fencers. Fencers not present at roll call will be excluded. **Roll calls will be held at the above times regardless of competition progress.**

Fencers must be aware of doping regulations. Any fencer may be tested.

Fencers must present proof of age (birth certificate or ID document) to enter. Those who cannot do so will not be allowed to enter.

Fencers are allowed to fence one age group up but not two.

There will be no separate U11 events. The U11's will fence in the U13 events. The top placed U11 in each U13 event will receive a gold medal.

The sabre Cadet event will run after the Juniors event only if there are 4 or more competitors.

Events will only take place with 4 or more competitors. Where an event is cancelled for this reason, awards will be in the next age group, as with the U11's. For example, if there is no U13 Ladies' Epee event, the top placed U13 in the U15 Ladies' Epee event will receive a gold medal.

Age Groups:

Juniors (U20) born after 1 January 1992

Cadets (U17) born after 1 January 1995

Minims (U15) born after 1 January 1997

Benjamins (U13) born after 1 January 1999
